

## UPDATE



Scott Sigler's works combine many genres, including science fiction, horror and thriller. His second major published novel, *Contagious*, made the New York Times best seller list. Its precursor, *Infected*, has been optioned as a motion picture production by Rogue Pictures.

Scott was also responsible for releasing the world's first podcast-only novel, *Earthcore*. All of his stories are freely available to listen to as audiobooks in serialised form at [www.scottsigler.com](http://www.scottsigler.com).

The two books by Scott currently available in Australia, *Infected* and *Contagious*, are a combination of horror, thriller and science fiction. They follow the story of Perry Dawsey, an ex-linebacker with a history of anger management issues who becomes infected by strange microscopic parasites. As the infection progresses, his self-control is put to the test.

Scott is releasing a self-published hardcover of his novel *The Rookie*. Set in a lethal pro football league 700 years in the future, *The Rookie* is a story that combines the intense gridiron action of "Any Given Sunday" with the space opera style of "Star Wars" and the criminal underworld of "The Godfather." The book is due for release in September 2009, and can be pre-ordered at Scott's website.

## UPDATE



Ian Irvine is a marine scientist who has developed some of Australia's national guidelines for the protection of the oceanic environment. He is best known for his fantasy series *The Three Worlds Cycle*, now comprising eleven novels. This series currently comprises of two quartets and a trilogy, and has been described as a "Darwinian fantasy", which details the struggle for survival between four human species. The first quartet is *The View From the Mirror*.

Ian's other published works include the *Human Rites* trilogy, the *Runcible Jones* quintet and *The Sorcerer's Tower*:

- The *Human Rites* trilogy is a set of eco-thrillers, covering issues such as environmental terrorism, global warming and genetic research gone wrong. The first book in this trilogy, *The Last Albatross*, has recently been republished by Simon and Schuster.
- The *Runcible Jones* quintet is a fantasy series for young adults set on twin worlds – an Earth where magic is illegal and power is vanishing from power stations, and Iltior, a world where everyone can use magic but science is forbidden. Three of the five books are currently available.
- The *Sorcerer's Tower* is a fantasy series written for primary school students. It chronicles the adventures of Tamly, the only person in the village Meadowhythe who can't perform magic, and also the only person who can save the village from the evil sorcerer Lord Harshax. There are four books in the series.
