

SwanCon 2010 Auction

It is intended that this auction will be run as an auction and not a comedy routine. Therefore it will be faster paced than recent auctions and probably over much quicker.

Buyers will be allowed to view the goods for auction for half an hour before the auction starts.

All care will be taken of the goods put up for auction but this does not imply any responsibility for those goods on behalf of the auctioneers or SwanCon.

Rules of the Auction

Sellers

- 1) No videos
- 2) Maximum of 10 items per person
- 3) Random books to be sold in sets
- 4) No weapons
- 5) Any last minute registrations will be held until the end of the auction
- 6) If an item does not reach its reserve price the seller can accept the highest bid but it is their duty to inform the auctioneer at the time of the bid. If they do not make their wishes known the item will be passed in.
- 7) It will take most of the next day to sort the accounts and so sellers should not expect to receive the proceeds of their sale before dinner on the next day.

Buyers

- 1) There will be no credit – you have to settle by the end of the auction.
- 2) You can not purchase something and foist it off onto someone who does not want it.
- 3) People or their services will not be auctioned.
- 4) You may not bid to get someone to do / not do something.
- 5) Once the hammer has fallen there will be no more bidding on the item.
